## History

The IHC Calf & Rural Scheme was launched in 1984, when Norm Cashmore trialled the scheme in Taranaki. Encouraged by the response, IHC rolled out the scheme across the country and expanded it to include all livestock. All Black great and sheep and beef farmer Sir Colin Meads is the schemes patron. “I’ve supported the scheme since it started and I think you should too”, he says.
